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Limitations of Research and Potential Risks:

The research on which this workshop is based has the following **limitations**:

1. The results are generated by research paradigms (i.e. quantitative and qualitative) that are limited by their methodologies, psychometrics (operational definitions), and sampling procedures.
2. The results may only apply to the subjects used in and at the time of the research.
3. The results of the research have not been replicated using different samples.

The **potential risks** of applying the research supporting this workshop are:

1. The most common risk is that the interpretations and applications of the results may not apply to individual, ethnic and cultural groups not sampled.
2. The most severe risk is that the misapplication of the results may be counterproductive to an individual's health and/or functioning.
